

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CALVARY WORSHIP CENTER OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD INC.**

We, the undersigned persons of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a non-profit corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is Calvary Worship Center of the Assemblies of God, Inc., and is hereinafter referred to in these Articles of Incorporation as “the corporation.”

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The period of duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III. NON-PROFIT CORPORATION AND ITS PURPOSES

The corporation is a non-profit corporation. The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as tax exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV. REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2700 Northland Drive, Austin, Travis County, Texas 78756, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Rev. Vic Schober.

ARTICLE V. INCORPORATORS AND INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is three (3). The names of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors and incorporators of the corporation are:

Rev. Roger Lewis

ARTICLE VI. AFFILIATION AND RELATIONSHIP

The corporation declares itself to be voluntarily in full cooperative fellowship with all other churches affiliated with The North Texas District Council of the Assemblies of God, and The General Council of the Assemblies of God, with headquarters in Springfield, Missouri, and shares in the privileges and assumes the responsibilities enjoined by this affiliation.

ARTICLE VII. LIABILITY OF DIRECTORS

Private property of the directors and officers of the corporation shall not be subject to debts or obligations of the corporation to any extent whatsoever.
